charges and rentals which apply from 15 February 1971 are shown in italics. The charges and rentals may be revised subsequently by the Post Office.

For an extension between buildings (external extension) there is a scale of connexion charges starting at £5 (£5) and a scale of additional rental starting at £1 5s (£1 \cdot 25), both based on distance.
