TELECOMMUNICATIONS

This arrangement enables you to make and receive calls at several different points in a house, or an office, without paying for a telephone instrument at each one. The line is connected to sockets, and a modern telephone or Trimphone with plug can be moved from point to point, as required.





Capacity

The exchange line is connected to any required number of sockets provided where needed in the house, or office.

Up to six telephones, each with plug, can be used in the sockets.

A main bell is provided, and up to five of the portable telephones can have bells. This number is reduced accordingly when additional bells are fitted, or when Trimphones are used.

Facilities

Except during a call, the telephones can be moved from socket to socket, as required. For example, a telephone can be carried upstairs for use during the night.

Calls can be made or received at any point. An incoming call always rings the main bell, any bell provided in a telephone plugged-in at the time, and any additional bells.

The modern telephones are available in the full range of colours to go with your decorations, and they can be provided without bells if required.

Luxury Trimphones, in a choice of three colours, can be provided for a small increase in rental; a change of instrument charge may also be payable.

Certain combinations of this arrangement with plans 1, 1A (see DLA 100) and the extension of plans 107, 107A (see DLA 103) are possible.

GENERAL INFORMATION

When connected to certain types of public exchange, the customer has to provide a mains supply for a ringing unit when more than two bells are required.

The telephone cords, plugs and sockets can be provided in grey or ivory, and the sockets, usually surface-mounted, can be flush-mounted if conduit and boxes have been provided.
