
Extension Arrangement Plan 9






EXTENSION ARRANGEMENTS AND PRESS-BUTTON SYSTEMS

This arrangement meets the needs of anyone who uses an extension from a private branch exchange and often wants to make an enquiry by telephone while holding the original call. One telephone is connected to two switchboard extension lines.





FACILITIES

Two extension lines are connected to one telephone, with press-button switching from one to the other.

All incoming calls are connected to the first extension line, and this is also used for normal outgoing calls.

Without interrupting a call on the first extension line, it is possible to press a button on the telephone and make an enquiry call on the second extension line, without any overhearing. Pressing the other button disconnects the second call and reconnects the first.

The operator can be recalled by pressing a button.

The telephone can be in a different building from the private branch exchange.

GENERAL INFORMATION

If the telephone is left connected to the enquiry extension line at the end of a call, it is automatically restored to the normal extension line when the handset is replaced.


