

ARRANGEMENTS AND

This simple extension arrangement is especially suitable for executives who have calls filtered by a secretary, but want secrecy on their own telephone when confidential matters are discussed. There is one extension, which can be cut off at any time by press-button on the main

telephone. Bell signalling is provided between the main and extension telephones, but speech between the two is not possible. The main telephone can be provided in black, two-tone grey, and ivory, and the extension telephone can be provided from the full range of colours.





FACILITIES

An incoming call normally rings both the bell in the main telephone and the bell in the extension telephone, and calls can be answered at either point.

The bell in the main telephone can be cut off by pressing a locking button. Incoming calls are then received by the extension.

Exchange calls can be made direct from either telephone.

The extension is cut off by pressing a button on the main telephone. Pressing another button reconnects the extension.

At any time, either telephone can be signalled from the other; additional bells are provided for this purpose. Users of both telephones can then take part in the same call. They cannot talk to one another unless an outside call is in progress.

GENERAL INFORMATION

If the extension is left cut off when a call ends, it is automatically reconnected when the handset on the main telephone is replaced.


