Not only does the 'Compact' give you a wider choice as to where you can have your telephone, there is also a bell volume control which you can adjust to suit its location.

### Space-saving

The 'Compact' telephone is much smaller than a standard telephone.




## Bell volume control

This enables you to adjust the volume of the telephone bell which is useful for example when there is sickness at home.

### Mobility

Because the 'Compact' telephone is lighter than standard telephones and has a cord that will extend up to 3 metres, you can enjoy your phone conversation virtually anywhere in a room.



## Wall-mounted version

The wall-mounted version of the 'Compact' is ideal for the kitchen, hall, or anywhere surfaces need to be kept clear.

The 'Compact' telephone then rests on its own neat little shelf unit which also incorporates the bell-unit.

# Separate bell-unit

The bell-unit (which incorporates the bell volume control) is separate from the 'Compact' telephone and is normally fitted nearby on a wall. However, for an extra charge, the bell-unit can be placed a greater distance from the 'Compact' telephone.
