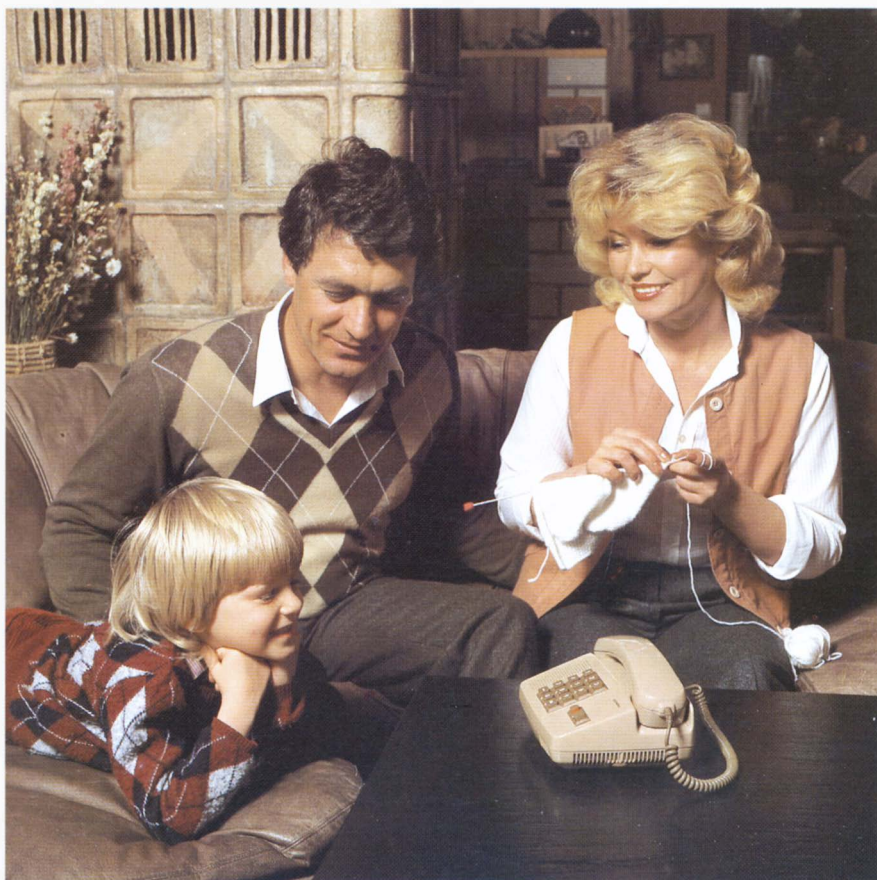
Handsfree talking

How often do you have to put the handset down and interrupt a telephone call to quickly look for and read some papers or to make notes.

The Siemens comfoset 150 gives you freedom of movement while telephoning. Not only at your desk, but around the whole room. You talk via the microphone and loudspeaker – with no “sound problems”.

If there are other persons in the room for whom the call is not intended, simply lift the handset. Your call is now private. If other persons should listen in but not contribute to the conversation, switch on the loudspeaker again. The volume can be easily regulated via the “loudspeaker” key.

The time you previously spent repeating information to colleagues or clarifying questions is now saved.



Handsfree talking at home

“Happy birthday to you!”
The whole family surprises Granny with 70th birthday greetings. By telephone. The handset does not have to be passed around. Everybody can hear right away how pleased Granny is. And Granny can hear the whole family singing, laughing and speaking.

On-hook dialing

With the feature handsfree talking you can also dial without lifting the handset. You can hear what is going on over the built-in loudspeaker: if the person you have called answers or not, or if the number is busy. When the dialed party answers you can immediately respond handsfree. You can naturally also conduct the call by way of the handset. The loudspeaker is then switched off automatically.



Speed calling for 10 addresses

How often do you have to dial or key in long telephone numbers digit by digit every day?

The Siemens comfoset 150 is also supplied with a pushbutton set for speed calling:

You can store under each digit key a telephone number of unlimited length, and dial it simply by pressing that key. Without having to dial the whole number again.

Automatic redialing

How often do you have to dial telephone numbers over and over again because the dialed party is either engaged or does not answer.

It needn't be so. By using automatic redialing, you can repeat the last number dialed as often as you like, simply by pressing a key. In this way you can save the time you would otherwise spend on the telephone **before** the dialed party answers.

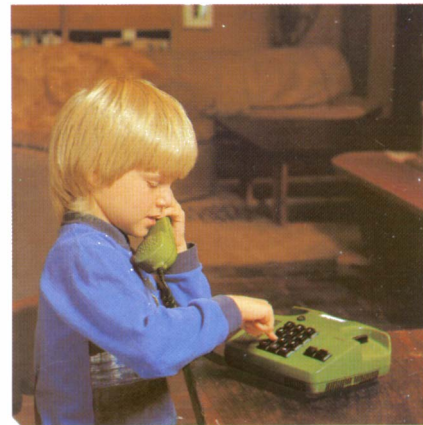
If the dialed party is busy or is not there, you can store this number temporarily and make other telephone calls in the meantime. It is not necessary to dial the whole number again later.

Keylock

How often do you leave your office or home with the uncomfortable feeling that your telephone can be used without your knowledge. With the keylock in the comfoset 150 you can prevent unauthorized use of your telephone simply by removing the key.

Calls can naturally still be received with the key removed.

If your telephone features speed calling, the **emergency call memory** function remains unaffected.



Emergency call memory

Who would want to be responsible if a locked telephone could not be used in an emergency. Or how often are there children alone at home who are too young to read or to dial telephone numbers.

For emergencies the Siemens comfoset 150 has a special safety feature: a certain call number can be selected from the emergency call memory (with the telephone locked) by pressing any of the keys. You can thus program in an "emergency number", such as for instance that of reception, ambulance service or fire department. As soon as a key is pressed, the comfoset 150 automatically dials this individually programmed number.

The Siemens comfoset 150 offers advantages for every office. And for the home.



The Siemens comfoset 150 is suitable for all applications where something more than a conventional telephone is required.

It can be connected as simply as any normal telephone, to any telephone system using dial pulsing or DTMF signaling. The comfoset 150 comes in different versions to suit your requirements:

- **Siemens comfoset 150** with handsfree talking and on-hook dialing.
- **Siemens comfoset 150** with handsfree talking, on-hook dialing, speed calling for 10 addresses, last number redial, keylock and emergency call memory.

The telephone is available in the colors light brown, dark brown and fern green. It has a modern, pleasing and practical design. Instead of the usual bell you hear an electronic tone, which you can adjust individually. There can thus be no more confusion when several telephones are grouped together at one location.
