

NOTES

- 1. BROKEN LINES REPRESENT NORMAL CONNEXIONS, FULL LINES NEW OR ALTERED CONNEXIONS.
- 2. RING AND SPEAK KEYS, ALSO RING BACK AND DIAL KEYS, WILL BE COMBINED.
- 3. RING AND RING BACK KEYS WILL BE ACTUATED BY MOVEMENT OF HANDLES TOWARDS OPERATOR.
- 4. KEYS AND PLUGS WILL BE LABELLED AS SHOWN.
- 5. THE MINIMUM P.D. WILL BE DETERMINED BY CONSIDERATION OF THE TRANSMISSION OR SIGNALLING REQUIREMENTS OF EACH INDIVIDUAL CASE.
- 6. APPARATUS THROWN OUT OF USE WILL BE RECOVERED UNLESS A REVERSION TO STANDARD ARRANGEMENTS IS CONTEMPLATED. INDICATORS 600 A WILL BE REPLACED BY INDICATORS 600 C.
- 7. NIGHT SERVICE WILL BE PROVIDED BY SEPARATE DOUBLE-PLUGGED CORDS.
- 8. THE EXCHANGE LINES MUST BE REVERSED IN ALL CASES.
- 9. THE DIAL KEY AND DIAL CIRCUIT TO BE FITTED IN AUTOMATIC AREAS ONLY.
