


NOTES:

- 1. This line +VE until called sub. answers, then -VE.
- 2. SU unlocks coin slots when energised by current reversal (See Note 1).
- 3. These points are connected by Jack 77D to provide "999" service with mechanism removed.
- 4. U point letter prefixes:-
 - SJ Slot unlocking Unit and Emergency Service.
 - TJ Test Jack on Pulser Unit.
 - PJ Pulser Unit.
- 5. When reversed in Jack Regulator connects 'B', 'C' and 'D' together, circuit then works without Regulator.
- 6. For wiring details of Box C.C. No.700 See N1169.
- 7. White wire of Handset Cord moved from T10 to T11.
- 8. Rectifier Element fitted to Receiver Terminals.
- 9. Colours in brackets refer to cable.
- 10. When Extension Bell required move white conductor of Cord 9/21AD from B19 to B17 and connect Bell between B17 and B18.
