- 2 THE TELEPHONE IS FITTED WITH A HIGH IMPEDANCE BELL AND IS INTENDED FOR PARALLEL WORKING USING LINE JACK UNIT..., OR JACK No. 620 SERIES.
- 3 LINE JACK UNIT.../IA, 2A OR 3A SHOULD BE USED AS APPROPRIATE. FOR PBX EXTERNAL EXTENSIONS A LINE JACK..../IA SHOULD BE USED IF PRIMARY SURGE PROTECTION IS REQUIRED AS DEFINED IN TI C3F0052 SECTION 4.
