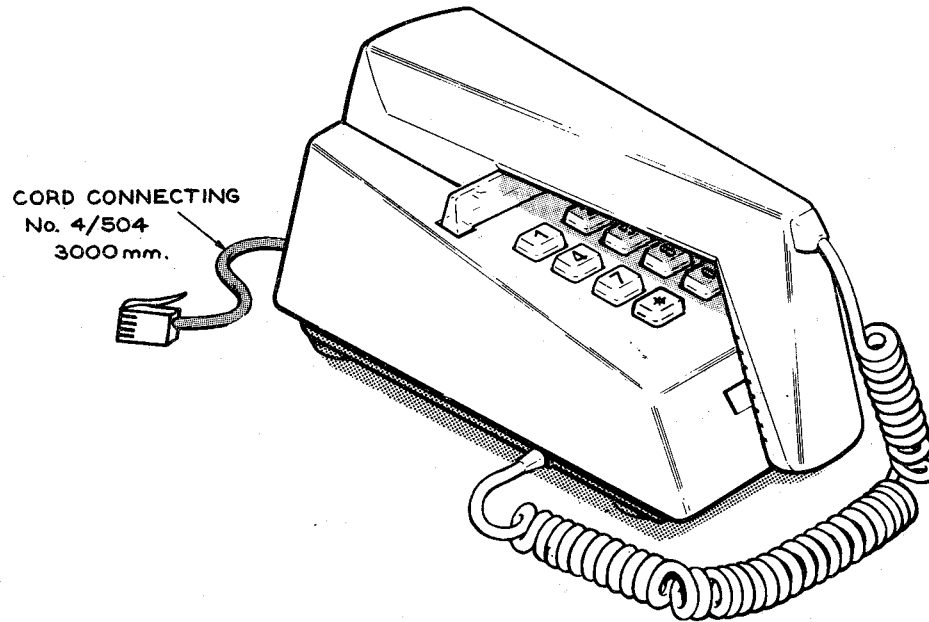

1. TELEPHONE No. 8786 IS A 12 BUTTON, MF4 SIGNALLING PRESS-BUTTON TELEPHONE, INTENDED FOR USE ON SUITABLY EQUIPPED PSTN LOCAL EXCHANGE LINES AND PBX'S.
2. THE TELEPHONE No. 8786 IS FITTED WITH A RESISTOR IN SERIES WITH THE TONE CALLER AND IS INTENDED FOR PARALLEL WORKING USING LINE JACK UNIT . . . , OR JACK No. 620 SERIES.
3. LINE JACK UNIT . . . /1A, 2A OR 3A SHOULD BE USED AS APPROPRIATE. FOR PBX EXTERNAL EXTENSIONS A LINE JACK UNIT . . . /1A SHOULD BE USED IF PRIMARY SURGE PROTECTION IS REQUIRED AS DEFINED IN T1 C3 F0052 SECTION 4.
4. ON SOME REFURBISHED PRESS-BUTTON TELEPHONES, TERMINALS 16, 17 & 18 DO NOT EXIST. THEY HAVE BEEN REDESIGNATED AS TERMINALS 2A, 19B & 19A RESPECTIVELY. THE BELL WILL BE CONNECTED BETWEEN TERMINALS T4 & T19, NOT BETWEEN TERMINALS T4 & T16 AS SHOWN. THE WHITE CONDUCTOR OF THE CORD CONNECTING No. 4/504 WILL BE CONNECTED TO T19 AND NOT T18 AS SHOWN.
