HOW to USE the (MAIN) TELEPHONE

RELEASE SPK TO EXCH HELD EXCH

- -TO MAKE AN EXCHANGE CALL, lift the handset, press the key, wait for dialling tone, then dial.
- -TO ANSWER AN EXCHANGE CALL, lift the handset, press this key and speak.
- TO SPEAK TO EXTENSION WHILE HOLDING AN EXCHANGE CALL, press—this key (the SPK TO EXCH will restore) and ring extension by pressing either of the two long unmarked keys.* The red light behind the key is to remind you that the exchange line is being held. If you wish to speak on the exchange line again press the SPK TO EXCH key.
- TO CONNECT EXCHANGE LINE TO EXTENSION, press this key (Ring the extension if necessary). The white light behind the key glows while the extension is speaking and will go out when the extension handset is replaced. If the key is left down, any fresh exchange call will ring the extension as well as the main bell (Buzzer on main, instead of bell, if the extension is "external").
- -TO SPEAK TO EXTENSION, without calling exchange, restore all keys to normal by pressing this key, which does not stay down. Ring the extension if necessary.
 - † Each of these keys stays down when pressed but pressing any one down releases either of the others.
 - *Ring extension keys; if there are two extensions each key will ring a particular extension.

Notes : -

- (i) An external extension, when calling the main, must operate the push button key before lifting the handset.
- (ii) Make sure that the plug is in the electric socket and that the switch, if there is one, is "on".
