
OBTAINING DIAL TONE - Allocation of Connecting Circuits








OUTGOING EXCHANGE LINE CALL - Trunking Sequence




OUTGOING EXCHANGE LINE CALL, - Seizure of Public Exchange Line








INCOMING EXCHANGE LINE CALL—Operator Answering




INCOMING EXCHANGE LINE CALL - Operator Answering




INCOMING EXCHANGE LINE CALL—Operator Keying Number of Wanted Extension






INCOMING EXCHANGE LINE CALL - Wiring of Extension M'wires to Finder





INCOMING EXCHANGE LINE CALL - Testing & Switching to Called Extension (free)





INTER P.A.B.X. CALL - Incoming Dialling Access




