Once you are on the phone it does not cost much to extend the service around the home. With a bedroom phone you never have to hurry downstairs to answer a call. A wall-phone in the kitchen is a boon for the busy housewife and helps keep working surfaces clear. And with a phone in the lounge you can enjoy a telephone conversation without moving from the comfort of your armchair.

First choose the arrangement that best suits you....

Fixed extensions

Fixed extension phones fitted to your line enable you to make and receive calls from more than one room in your home. With the most popular fixed extension arrangement (Plan 1A) up to three extensions can normally be installed. Each has its own phone and bell (or a tone caller in the case of a trimphone) which can be switched off individually.

Fixed extensions with intercommunication

Some fixed extension arrangements can also give intercommunication facilities which enable you to call the other extension phones in your home.

Plug and socket arrangements (Plan 4)

A telephone can be made mobile by changing it to a plug-in phone and having socket outlets installed at suitable points. A fixed main bell is provided. The portable phone also has a bell (or a tone caller with a Trimphone) which only rings when the phone is plugged in. You are advised not to move the phone between sockets during a call. Additional portable phones can be added to meet your needs.

Combinations of extension arrangements

A variety of extension arrangements is possible. A combination of plugs, sockets and fixed phones may help you to obtain a more suitable system. You can build up from the simplest combination which provides a fixed main phone, a portable phone and two sockets.

Tablephones

The tablephone comes in seven colours specially chosen to enhance room settings:-

Wallphones

These space-saving phones are available in three colours.

Trimphones

A small lightweight phone, with special features, to add style to your home. Not only does it have a different shape, it also makes a different noise – an intermittent warble – and has a dial that glows in the dark. The Trimphone is available for a small extra charge.

Press-Button Telephones

A modern, efficient, easier-to-use phone at a reasonable extra cost. Press-button Trimphones and table and wall-mounted versions of the Press-Button Telephone are now available.

Note: Press-Button Telephones

Due to the gradual introduction of new equipment throughout the British Telecom Public Telephone System, customers ordering press-button telephones may be provided with either ten or twelve button models, and in some instances a new dial tone. Users of the twelve button models will also hear a 'confidence tone' on depression of the press-buttons. This tone varies between pressbuttons, simply informing the user that the telephone is functioning correctly.

Initially there will be no new facilities provided with the additional buttons, but their introduction is the groundwork for future new customer services. Because of this, no choice will be offered, and there will be no difference in charges.
